By Laws Article X — Races

Section 5. The time limit will be 7 1/2 minutes per mile. In all races except those with combined classes A, B. C. D. the first vacht finishes her race after completing the scheduled number of laps within the time limit. Irregardless of which lap she is sailing, anv following vacht finishes the race when she crosses the finish line after the finish of the first vacht. In each race a vacht will be scored ahead of all yachts with fewer laps. Anv vacht not crossing the finish line within 30 minutes of the first vacht will be scored according to her finish in the previous lap. If she has completed no laps, she will be scored DNF.

In combined A. B, C. D. races, the first vacht must complete the scheduled number of laps within the time limit. All other yachts must complete the scheduled number of laps and any yacht finishing more than 30 minutes after the first yacht finishes will be scored DNF (Did Not Finish)

By Laws Article XII - Scoring - COMPUTATION OF POINTS

Section 1 Following the first paragraph that ends with "Lowest total points wins". Insert a new paragraph to read:

Race finishing positions shall be determined according to Article X, Section 5.

Reasons for this proposal.

- 1) In the proposed system for recording the finishing positions, any yacht that has completed at least one lap
 - will receive a score for the race, even if she is unable to complete all the laps.
- 2) The proposed system saves time and allows more races to be held on a given day.

A motion was made by Steve Schalk to approve the above proposal. Motion was defeated for lack of second

<u>Section 7.</u> Schedule of Races (all times are local times). No race starts after 30 minutes prior to sunset as posted on Regatta Notice Board. At the discretion of the Race Committee, the starting order and time for Saturday and Sunday may be altered to allow make-up races to be moved to the front of the rotation. Such alterations in schedule shall be posted on Friday and Saturday evening on the Regatta Notice Board.
