The 2019 Northwest Ice Yacht Association Annual Regatta was held January 19 to 20, 2019, at Lake City on Lake Pepin, a very beautiful setting in which to sail. The ice was 12" thick, smooth as glass, and hard. It was quite cold. The racing began with about ¼" of snow on the ice. The wind was moderate at best, there were eight stern steerers in attendance. One round of races were completed on Friday, then visibility dropped as another couple inches of snow arrived. Saturday was just enough wind for most boats to sail through the new snow, two more rounds of races were completed. 



